



Presenting the ADA Medal Award Program

Commencing with competitions January 1st, 2021

Rider Performance Award:

- 4 scores of 60.000% or higher from any 2 of Training, First or Second level tests from at least 2 different competitions and 4 different judges from 4 different tests
- FEI 4 Year Old Tests are equivalent to Training Level so could be used for Training Level Requirement
- FEI 5 Year Old Tests are equivalent to Second Level so could be used for Second Level Requirement
- Eligible shows: AEF Wild Rose; EC Bronze; EC Silver; EC Gold
- No time limit or horse restrictions (scores can be achieved on different horses over any number of years). Eligible shows must be held in Alberta or sanctioned by AEF if out of province.
- Must be a member of an ADA area group.

Bronze Medal:

- 6 scores of 60.000% or higher from Training, First, and Second Levels
- 2 scores from each level from 2 different judges and 2 different tests
- FEI Pony Tests; FEI Children Tests are equivalent to Second Level so could be used as the Second Level requirement
- FEI 4 Year Old Tests are equivalent to Training Level so could be used for Training Level Requirement
- FEI 5 Year Old Tests are equivalent to Second Level so could be used for Second Level Requirement
- Eligible shows: AEF Wild Rose; EC Bronze; EC Silver; EC Gold; FEI sanctioned
- No time or horse restrictions (scores can be achieved on different horses over any number of years). Eligible shows must be held in Alberta or sanctioned by AEF if out of province.
- Must be a member of an ADA area group.

Silver Medal:

- 4 scores of 60.000% or higher
- 2 scores from 3rd Level and 2 scores from 4th Level with 2 different judges and 2 different tests
- FEI Junior tests are equivalent to Third Level so could be used as the Third Level requirement
- FEI 6 Year Old Tests are equivalent to Third Level so could be used for Third Level Requirement
- FEI 7 Year Old Tests are equivalent to Developing Prix St. Georges, FEI Prix St. Georges or Fourth Level, so could be used for Fourth Level Requirement
- Eligible shows: EC Gold; FEI sanctioned



- No time or horse restrictions (scores can be achieved on different horses over any number of years). Eligible shows must be held in Alberta or sanctioned by AEF if out of province.
- Must be a member of an ADA area group.

Gold Medal:

- 4 scores of 60.000% or higher
- 2 scores from PSG and 2 scores from Intermediate I with 2 different judges and 2 different tests
- FEI Young Rider tests are equivalent to PSG so could be used as the PSG requirement
- FEI 7 Year Old Tests are equivalent to Developing Prix St. Georges, FEI Prix St. Georges or Fourth Level, so could be used for Prix St. Georges Level Requirement
- Eligible shows: EC Gold; FEI sanctioned
- No time or horse restrictions (scores can be achieved on different horses over any number of years). Eligible shows must be held in Alberta or sanctioned by AEF if out of province.
- Must be a member of an ADA area group.

Platinum Medal:

- 4 scores of 60.000% or higher
- Each level with 2 different judges and 2 different tests.
- 2 scores from Intermediate II and 2 scores from Grand Prix OR 4 from Grand Prix
- FEI Intermediate A and B tests are equivalent to Intermediate II so could be used as the Intermediate II requirement
- FEI U25 test could be used as the Grand Prix requirement
- Grand Prix Special could be used as the Grand Prix requirement
- Eligible shows: EC Gold; FEI sanctioned
- No time or horse restrictions (scores can be achieved on different horses over any number of years). Eligible shows must be held in Alberta or sanctioned by AEF if out of province.
- Must be a member of an ADA area group.

General Directives for Individual Performance and Medal Awards

If the test scores are an average of 2 or more judges, the average score must be considered a single score to be used as a requirement.

If a judge was a member of a judging panel on a submitted average score, that judge's score could be used on a different submitted score on a different test if that judge was adjudicating alone.

Copies of Tests must accompany the Submission Form in order to validate scores. Scans of tests are accepted. To apply for the Rider Performance Award or Medal



Awards, the Submission Form and copies of applicable tests will be sent to the ADA Secretary upon completion of the Award requirements. An Awards Committee will be appointed to assist the secretary, if necessary.
