

She can also judge WSDAC (Western Dressage) Shows, using WSDAC tests. Thankfully she will be bringing her daughter to scribe do to covid so be aware the 6ft requirement isn't necessary for them.

# Location

The one-day show will be held at Edgewood Stables, located in Lethbridge Alberta. This location is just on the corner of 13<sup>th</sup> Street North and 62 Avenue North. Edgewood Stables has an indoor and outdoor riding arena.

### **Stabling**

No stabling is available for this show.

# Schedule

The show will take place September 12, 2020. The show start and end times will depend on the number of entries. The full schedule of ride times will be posted after the closing date, no later than Thursday September 10th, 2020.

Due to the current pandemic situation 2 riders will be "paired up" and riding tests alternating, 10 minutes will be allotted for each test and where possible 10 minutes will be allotted in between rider pair changes/ scoring to help ensure riders are able to vacate the premises as soon as possible after their tests.

The schedule will also be emailed to the person listed as "contact person" on the entry form.

# Competition and Facility Rules

The show will be conducted according to AEF rules as per the Wildrose Rulebook (available on <u>www.albertaequestrian.com</u>) as such, current 2020 AEF membership for Rider and Horse Owner is required. The dressage will follow the rules in Chapter 10 in the Wildrose Rulebook as well as the Equine Canada rules.

The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an exhibitor, trainer or other person at an AEF Wild Rose sanctioned competition shall not be tolerated under any circumstances. The competition organizing committee has the right to bar such violators from further participation in the competition if necessary

Additional Rules:

- Weather permitting, the outdoor arena will be used as a warm-up arena. In inclement weather, a 20-minute warm-up period will be available in the competition ring to be shared by the two riders that are scheduled to ride next. One rider will have to wait in the ring while the other rider completes their test(s). It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that their horse does not interfere with tests in progress. Excessively unruly horses may be asked to leave.
- Lunging will not be permitted.
- Riders are to supply their own readers, if desired.
- All athletes must wear approved protective headwear at all times while mounted at the show. This applies to warm up areas as well. See the AEF Wildrose Rule book for Dressage for approved headwear.
- Each horse and rider combination may compete in a maximum of 4 classes per day. The horse/ rider combination may ride the same test multiple times, or ride different tests.
- The safety committee may in their discretion disqualify a rider from continuing a test and riding subsequent tests as a result of an unplanned dismount or other accident.
- No dogs allowed.
- No littering, this includes cigarette butts and sunflower seeds.
- Bring your own feed and water buckets if required.
- Horses are not to be left unattended if tied to a trailer.
- All horses should be up to date with current vaccinations within the last 12 months but not within 7 days of competition.

### COVID 19 Rules (IMPORTANT MUST READ):

**Preventing COVID-19 spread**: If anyone attending the show becomes sick within two (2) weeks following the show, contact the show organizer Melissa Smith by email <u>mrsdressage@gmail.com</u> and indicate the event and date that they were onsite.

**Social Distancing:** Weather permitting, the competition office will be located outside but will require 6 feet distancing between all persons. Only riders and volunteers will be permitted in the show office, riders will be responsible for picking up/ dropping off the Daily Waver of Symptoms for anyone accompanying them when they pickup their numbers. Only riders will be able to pick up their tests and Certificates of Achievement. Only 2 people can enter the competition office at one time, other than the show organizer (3 people total). Hand sanitizer will be provided at the registration table, all pens, numbers etc. will be sanitized in-between uses.

### Arrival:

Admission to Show: only the rider, and 1 to 2 people who are grooms/coach/parents of the rider are permitted on the show grounds and must be listed on the "Persons Accompanying the Rider Form" along with all contact information. Substitutions will be allowed but the COVID Compliance Officer must be notified the day of the show and all contact information must be submitted along with a Daily Waiver of Symptoms Form. Riders can grab show numbers and if needed blank Daily waivers (if unable to preprint forms for completion the day of the show) for themselves and anyone accompanying them.

**Daily Waiver of Symptoms:** All Participants (rider, groom, coach, or anyone accompanying you) must complete a daily attestation form and symptoms screening when you come to the venue. If they have any symptoms, they should not come to the venue (note the AHS poster).

**Persons Accompanying the Rider Form must be submitted with your entry form:** For monitoring and to allow for contact tracing of the Participants entering the venue, require competitors to list the support personnel they will have with them for the competition as part of their entry, including the name, phone number and email for the coach, groom, parent or responsible adult (if a minor).

**Other paperwork:** All other paperwork should be done before the show so that the daily waivers, numbers and Certificates of Achievement will be the only "close contact" you will have with the Clinic Organizer.

**Sanitation and Masks:** Hand sanitizer will be available at the show office, otherwise bring your own sanitizer. Masks are optional and will not be provided.

**Tacking Up and Untacking:** Weather is permitting it is preferred haul in horses are tacked up outside, if this is not possible, every other tack up stall will be blocked for distancing purposes. With the scheduling the number of persons in the tack area should be easily limited to 3 persons, signs will be posted if necessary, to indicate direction of entry and exiting the barn.

**Warm Up Ring:** Riders will enter the west gate to warm up, 4 riders maximum in the warmup area and maintain the required **5m between horses** at all times, they will exit to the east to ride their first test and will be allowed to re-enter the warm up through this gate in-between tests and will have priority over someone riding in the next "pair" of riders.

After Your Final Test: Leave the show ring area using the road North of the warmup ring, untack first to give the show office time to complete scoring and Certificates of Achievement. Proceed to the show office to turn in numbers and pick up certificates. The show is requesting anyone not volunteering to leave the premises after receiving certificates to allow for proper people/ horse flow and social distancing measures.

### AHS Poster: You must comply with this poster as directed by AHS;



**Signage** should clearly state that anyone who has a fever, exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, has tested positive for COVID-19 and not been cleared by health authorities, or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two (2) weeks should not enter the competition venue. (A (daily) waiver will be signed by the driver and clinic participant and accompanying groom/assistant(s).

Make cheques out to "Chinook Country / Alberta Dressage Association", this year due to COVID and higher risk of cancelation NO CASH will be accepted.

Though the drop off envelop will be monitored regularly, CC/ADA will not be responsible for any mishaps due to dropping off entries at Edgewood Stables

### **Memberships**

# All riders and horse owners require current AEF membership. Please submit a copy of the membership card with your entry form.

The Chinook Country / Alberta Dressage Association (CC/ADA) is supporting this show. All CC/ADA members are eligible for a discounted class price.

### Cancellation

In case of lack of entries, the CC/ADA reserves the right to cancel or postpone the show. In event of postponement or cancellation, all competitors will be notified, and all applicable entry fees will be refunded. A "back up" judge has been pre-arranged in the event the judge cancels at the last minute due to COVID restrictions.

### **Refunds and Changes**

Free substitutions of the horse and/or rider are allowed up to September 9, 2020 and anyone who symptoms or who has tested positive for COVID-19 and not been cleared by health authorities, or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two (2) weeks should not enter the competition venue and will be fully refunded for their show fees.

# Prizes

Riders qualify for Certificates of Achievement based on the average score of their best two classes; riders must obtain scores in at least two classes to qualify for a Certificate of Achievement.

Platinum – 70.000% + Gold – 65.000% to 69.999% Silver – 60.000% to 64.999% Bronze – 55.000% to 59.999% Participation – 50.000% to 54.999%
