

Locations

The show will be held as two separate events with the same classes being provided at each location. On Saturday at Vales Prairie Trails – 81011 Range Road 211, Lethbridge County, AB On Sunday at The Stables at Pavan – 94005 Range Road 215, Lethbridge County, AB.

Schedule

The show committee reserves the right to amalgamate both days into one day if there are insufficient entries for two days. In this case any competitors who have entered both days will receive a refund for the second day's entry and those who cannot come because of a day change will also be refunded.

Times will depend on the number of entries. The full schedule of ride times will be posted after the closing date, no later than the Wednesday immediately preceding the show.

Competition and Facility Rules

The show will be conducted according to AEF rules as per the Wild Rose Rulebook (available on www.albertaequestrian.com). The dressage will follow the rules in Chapter 10 in the Wild Rose Rulebook as well as the Equine Canada rules. The western dressage will follow the WSDAC Rule Book and Pony Club will follow their Rule book

New for 2024 All riders must be members of The Alberta Dressage Association. If not already a member of an area group they can purchase a showing membership (\$10 Adult, \$7 Youth) good for the whole 2024 season. **This is an Insurance requirement.**

The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an exhibitor, trainer or other person at an AEF Wild Rose sanctioned competition shall not be tolerated under any circumstances. The competition organizing committee has the right to bar such violators from further participation in the competition if necessary.

Additional Rules:

- The warm-up area will be located outdoors; the competition ring will be indoors.
- Lunging will only be permitted outdoors at the agreement of others warming up or when the area is empty.
- Test readers will not be provided.
- All athletes must wear approved protective headwear at all times while mounted at the show. This includes both English and western riders and applies to warm up areas as well.
- Each horse and rider combination may compete in a maximum of 3 classes per day.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse entries, split, cancel, or combine, and/or adjust any class at its discretion. The Show Committee also reserves the right to remove any horse and/or rider from the competition without being liable for compensation (EC rule A603.2).
- No dogs allowed.
- No littering, this includes cigarette butts and sunflower seeds.

Memberships

All riders and horse owners require current AEF membership. Please submit a copy of the membership card with your entry form. BC or Saskatchewan residents, equivalent horse organisation accepted.

Competitors for the Para Dressage Classes must be registered para dressage riders.

All CC/ADA members get a \$30 discount on entries for each Show I and Show II.

Cancellation

In case of severe weather, unsafe footing, or lack of entries, the show management reserves the right to cancel or postpone the show. In event of postponement or cancellation, all competitors will be notified and all entry fees will be refunded. The show may still run in moderate rain or cooler temperatures so please prepare accordingly.

Refunds and Changes

As this is a small show, we regret to inform you that refunds are not possible after the show closing date except with a letter from a vet or doctor. Beyond this, changes to your entry can be made with a charge of \$20/change. This applies to changes in horse, rider, or class. Management reserves the right to refuse changes after the ride times have been published.

Prizes

Classes will have ribbons awarded to 3rd place. Any horse and rider pair earning a score of less than 50% on a test will not be eligible for ribbons or prizes.

The Show Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse entries, split, cancel, or combine, and/or adjust any class at its discretion. All classes and divisions will be placed as open (no separation between JR/AA/O). Competitors riding in the Pony Club Class must be members of the Pony Club.

Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons and prizes will be awarded to the top two horse and rider combinations in each division at each show. These standings will be calculated by adding the rider's two best dressage scores.

A High Score ribbon for the highest score for the Pony Club TOC (PC Pre-training up to EC Level 4) will be awarded at each show.


Divisions may be combined if they have less than 3 horse and rider combinations. In the case of combined divisions, scores at higher levels will be multiplied by a factor of

1.1 when compared to the scores of a lower level.

Thoroughbred Incentive Program


The Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) is created to encourage the retraining of Thoroughbreds into other disciplines upon completion of careers in racing or breeding, T.I.P. offers incentives for competition horses, recreational horses, young riders and Thoroughbreds in a non-competitive second career as well as a Championship horse show.

We are offering a **T.I.P. High Score Award** for English dressage disciplines over the 2 days of Show I and Show II.

New for 2024 An End of Season Award for the High Score Averaged over the 2 CCADA Lethbridge Shows

The calculation of these High Score (Dressage) awards, following T.I.P. guidelines, is based on the degree of difficulty of the test. The following points are added to the final percentage score.

- Training +1
- First Level +3
- Second Level +5
- Third Level +7
- Fourth Level +9
- FEI Levels +11



For purposes of eligibility for all T.I.P. classes and awards, a "Thoroughbred" is defined as any horse that has been registered with The Jockey Club or a foreign Thoroughbred stud book recognized by The Jockey Club. It must be registered with T.I.P and given a T.I.P number prior to the show entry.

Fun begins at 40

This Prize is open to all riders who are considered Adult Amateur according to the WR definition (WR General – Definitions). It is open to all qualified riders. One prize for each day of the show.

To enter, riders must be 40 years of age or older as of the day of the Show. This prize will be awarded to the rider with the highest single score of the show including freestyle. **Riders must register on their entry form or at the show office by noon on the morning of the show.** There is no fee for this entry.
