

**In the Afternoon at Vales Prairie Trails** – 81011 Range Road 211, Lethbridge County, AB situated on the south side of Lethbridge off Hwy 4.

## Schedule

Times will depend on the number of entries. The full schedule of ride times will be posted after the closing date, no later than the Wednesday immediately preceding the show.

# Competition and Facility Rules

The show will be conducted according to AEF rules as per the Wild Rose Rulebook (available on <a href="https://www.albertaequestrian.com">www.albertaequestrian.com</a>). The dressage will follow the rules in Chapter 10 in the Wild Rose Rulebook as well as the Equine Canada rules. The western dressage will follow the WSDAC Rule Book and Pony Club will follow their Rule book

The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an exhibitor, trainer or other person at an AEF Wild Rose sanctioned competition shall not be tolerated under any circumstances. The competition organizing committee has the right to bar such violators from further participation in the competition if necessary

#### Additional Rules:

- The warm-up area will be located outdoors; the competition ring will be indoors.
- Lunging will only be permitted outdoors at the agreement of others warming up or when the area is empty.
- Test readers will not be provided.
- All athletes must wear approved protective headwear at all times while mounted at the show. This includes both English and western riders, and applies to warm up areas as well.
- Each horse and rider combination may compete in a maximum of 3 classes per day.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse entries, split, cancel or combine, and/or adjust any class at its discretion. The Show Committee also reserves the right to remove any horse and/or rider from the competition without being liable for compensation (EC rule A603.2).
- No dogs allowed.
- No littering, this includes cigarette butts and sunflower seeds.

## **COVID-19 Measures**

Do not come to the show grounds if you are experiencing any symptoms or have suspected contact with anyone with COVID-19.

This show will conform to any necessary health orders that are in effect at the time of the event.

While masks and social distancing are not currently required, please respect those that may still wish to take precautions. Tests and scores can be returned virtually for anyone who wants that.

## **Memberships**

This is an AEF Wild Rose Show. All riders and horse owners require current AEF membership. Please submit a copy of the membership card with your entry form. BC or Saskatchewan residents, equivalent horse organisation accepted.

All CC/ADA members get a \$30 discount on entries

#### Cancellation

In case of severe weather, unsafe footing, or lack of entries, the show management reserves the right to cancel or postpone the show. The show may also be cancelled related to COVID-19 if there is an increase in local cases or changes to Alberta health regulations or recommendations. In event of postponement or cancellation, all competitors will be notified and all entry fees will be refunded. The show may still run in moderate rain or cooler temperatures so please prepare accordingly.

## **Refunds and Changes**

As this is a small show, we regret to inform you that refunds are not possible after the show closing date. However, a refund will be possible with a letter from a vet or doctor, or in the case of a positive COVID-19 test.

Apart from the above, changes to your entry can be made with a charge of \$20/change. This applies to changes in horse, rider, or class. The show committee reserves the right to refuse changes after the ride times have been published.

#### **Number of Classes to Be Entered**

A maximum of 2 Classes per day for each horse are permitted.

## **Prizes**

Classes will have ribbons awarded to 3<sup>rd</sup> place. In the event of a class having less than 3 entries the show committee reserves the right to combine a class within that Division. Any horse and rider pair earning a score of less than 50% on a test will not be eligible for ribbons or prizes.

The Show Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse entries, split, cancel or combine, and/or adjust any class at its discretion. All classes will be placed as open (no separation between JR/AA/O). Competitors riding in the Pony Club Class must be members of the Pony Club.

A High Score ribbon for the highest score for the Pony Club TOC (PC Pre-training up to EC Level 4) will be awarded at each show.

Classes within a division may be combined if they have less than 3 horse and rider combinations. In the case of combined classes, scores at higher levels will be multiplied by a factor of 1.1 and 2.2 when compared to the scores of a lower level.


# Thoroughbred Incentive Program

The Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) is created to encourage the retraining of Thoroughbreds into other disciplines upon completion of careers in racing or breeding, T.I.P. offers incentives for competition horses, recreational horses, young riders and Thoroughbreds in a non-competitive second career as well as a Championship horse show.

We are offering a **T.I.P. High Score Award** for both English and Western dressage disciplines.

The calculation of these High Score (Dressage) awards, following T.I.P. guidelines, is based on the degree of difficulty of the test. The following points are added to the final percentage score.

- Training +1
- First Level +3
- Second Level +5
- Third Level +7
- Fourth Level +9
- FEI Levels +11



For purposes of eligibility for all T.I.P. classes and awards, a "Thoroughbred" is defined as any horse that has been registered with The Jockey Club or a foreign Thoroughbred stud book recognized by The Jockey Club. It must be registered with T.I.P and given a T.I.P number prior to the show entry.

# Fun begins at 40

- This Prize is open to all riders who are considered Adult Amateur according to the WR definition (WR General Definitions). It is open to all qualified riders. One prize for each location
- To enter, riders must be 40 years of age or older as of the day of the Show. This prize will be awarded to the rider with the highest single score of the show including freestyle.
- Riders must register on their entry form or at the show office by noon on the morning of the show
- No fee for this class.
