ARTICLE E 7.11.9 MAXIMUM NUMBER OF LEVELS/TESTS/CLASSES PER HORSE PER DAY

- 1. A horse/rider combination may compete in any two, but only two consecutive levels and a maximum of four tests per day including the freestyle.
- 2. No horse may compete in more than four tests or rides combined per day, including the freestyle
- . 3. A horse may compete in any two, but only two consecutive levels and a maximum of four tests per day including the freestyle.
 - 4. More than one athlete may compete on a given horse, but the horse may not compete against itself.
- 5. Equitation, Materiale and non-EC classes are included in the maximum of four classes per day.
 - 6. In-hand classes are exempt from this rule.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- * All questions are to be directed to the Show Secretary.
- * Any riding time changes must be approved by the show secretary prior to the competition.
- * No person other than the officials, attendants on duty and the judges of the class may enter the show ring without permission from the officials. Competitors entering the arena outside of the posted warm up times will be eliminated.
- * The Show Committee reserves the right to remove any horse/ rider from the competition without being liable for compensation.
- * Test readers are available, Please indicate on entry if you need one.
- * Standard whip length is 120cm. (including lash) and ponies riding in ANY class can only carry a whip of 100cm. Including lash.
- * Dogs are always welcome however for safety reasons, we ask that you please keep your dog on a leash at all times. For safety and sanitary reasons, no dogs will be permitted in the schooling area, show rings or show office.
- * Riders must wear approved helmets at all times while mounted on show grounds.
- * Areas to be used for warm up/lunging will be posted.
- * Must follow Cold Lake Ag Society rules available at www.coldlakeag.com
- *AEF# must be provided as it is required by the Cold Lake Ag Society and Alberta Wild Rose.

AEF HELMET POLICY

- 1.1 AEF Helmet Policy All riders, regardless of age or level, must wear ASTM/SEI, BSI/BS, EN, AS/NZS, or CE VG1 01.040 2014-12 (provided they are BSI Kitemarked) approved protective headgear at all times, with chin strap fastened, when mounted at any AEF sanctioned Wild Rose competition unless specifically exempted by the rules of the discipline.
- 1.2 Stallions Well-mannered stallions may ONLY be shown by junior A and adult competitors.
- 1.3 Age Categories Age categories shall follow Equestrian Canada's guidelines, based on the individual's age as of January 1 of the competition year:

a. Adult: 18 years and over

- b. Junior "A": The beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18.
- c. Junior "B": The beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 13 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 15.
- d. Junior "C": Until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 12.

COMPETITION NUMBER

The competition number designated to the horse/rider combination by the Show Secretary must be worn by the horse or horse/handler from the time it is issued whenever the horse is not in its stall or trailer, in order to facilitate identification by officials. A warning will be issued the first time the horse is seen without its designated number. The second offence may result in elimination or disqualification as determined by the Ground Jury, Steward or Show Committee.
