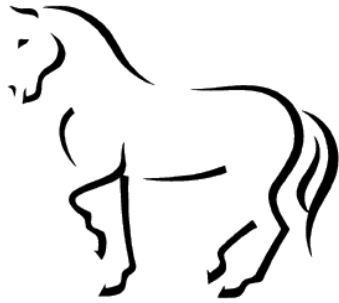

Current membership with the Alberta Equestrian Federation (AEF) will be mandatory to compete. All PAADA members competing in these shows will be eligible for prizes awarded at the PAADA Annual General Meeting and Awards Presentations.

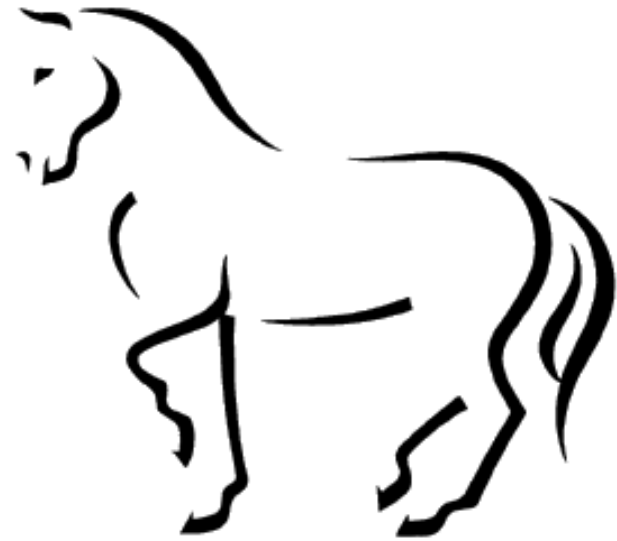
