The 2024 PRADA Dressage Show is a sanctioned competition of Alberta Equestrian Federation and Western Style Dressage Association of Canada and is governed by their rules. Every class offered herein is covered by their rules and specifications and will be held and judged in accordance with the same. Exhibitors, judges and show officials are responsible for knowledge of the rules.

General Rules and Information:

- The show committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. AEF and WSDAC rules and regulations will be followed.
- Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees.
- Any exhibitor using a wrong number, or having no number, may be excused, or disqualified from the class, at the judge's discretion.
- Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Show Management reserves the right to remove a groom, handler/ rider and/ or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.
- No person other than officials, staff on duty, and the judges of the classes may enter the competition ring without permission of the tournament management. Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing.
- Numbers will be assigned to all horses (Stabled, non-stabled, showing, and non-showing) and are required to wear the number while on the show grounds.

The show committee reserves the right to remove any horse and/or rider from the competition at any time without being liable for compensation.

The show committee reserves the right to refuse, cancel, postpone, change, reschedule or combine any class or condition they deem advisable.

Entries Close: Entries must be post marked no later than June 14, 2024. Entries are not considered valid until <u>all</u> completed documents are received and entry fees are paid in full. Show committee reserves the right to limit entries to 40 tests per day; valid entries accepted 1st come 1st served. **Entries received after the 40 tests will be placed on waiting list**.

PRESENTATIONS/AWARDS

Ribbons will be presented to 4th place for all test competitions **Prize money:** \$40.00 to 1st place, \$20.00 to 2nd place, \$10.00 to 3rd place **Highpoint Awards:** There will be 2 highpoint awards presented on Day 1 and Day 2. To qualify for Daily HP awards; average of 2 scores per day.

Presentations: Please pickup your ribbons, winnings and test pages at the Show Office.

AGE AND CLASS CLARIFICATION

- Junior category is open to all riders until the end of the calendar year, when they reach the age of 25.
- Open category is open to all riders regardless of age or status.
- Juniors riding stallions must be aware of Article E.7.11.6 Equine Canada rules.
- Junior riders can ride either category in a division, but not both.
- Riders can ride two consecutive tests per day.

RING REGULATIONS

- All classes will be in a 20m x 60m outdoor ring.
- Competitors entering the show ring outside of posted times will be eliminated.
- Scoring area and judges' booth are off limits except to show officials.
- Do not approach the judges' booth during competition.
- Warm-up arena in designated area.

<u>STABLING</u>

- LIMITED indoor stalls are available for \$25/stall per night and outdoor panel stalls for \$15/stall per night. Cleaning deposit of \$50.00 (separate cheque) is required and will be returned after inspection of the cleaned stall. Please see show office for stall assignments and refunds. There are no tack stalls available. **Competitors must provide own feed, shavings, water bucket and cleaning tools.**
- Stalls will be available from 4 p.m. on Friday June 21, 2024 to 7 p.m. Sunday June 23, 2024.
- Horses must be stabled in assigned stalls only.
- Competitors are responsible for keeping the area in front of their stall clean for the duration of the show.
- Camping on-site \$20/night, no hookups
- Please dump soiled bedding in designated areas.

ENTRY REGULATIONS

Exhibitors, judges and show officials are responsible for knowledge of the rules. Full details of horse show operation, EC rules, list of recognized judges and other vital information is in the Rule Book (copyright for the exclusive use of recognized EC shows). Both riders and owners must be members in good standing of Alberta Equestrian Federation (or your Provincial organization if you reside outside of Alberta).

1. Closing Date: Show entries must be post marked no later than June 14, 2024. Show will run rain or shine.

2. **Incomplete Entries** submitted will be subject to an additional \$20.00 administration fee and considered invalid until all information is submitted or corrected by CLOSING DATE.

3. Post Entries are not accepted.

4. **Payments:** An entry is not considered valid until it has been paid in full. No post dated cheques will be accepted. Cheques and money orders should be made out to Peace Region Alberta Dressage Association.

5. **Limited Entries:** Priority of entry goes to complete and correct entries. Incomplete entries will go to the bottom of the priority list until corrected. Show committee reserves the right to limit entries to 40 tests per day; entries accepted first come first served. Entries received after the 40 tests will be placed on waiting list.

6. **Signatures:** All competitors must sign the release and acknowledgement of risk form. Riders under 18 must have a parent or guardian signature.

7. **Riders:** A rider may ride more than one horse.

8. More than one competitor may ride the same horse providing the horse is not entered by two riders in the same class & the horse may not be in more than four tests per day. Failure to comply will result in elimination of that horse.

9. There will be a **Veterinarian** and **Farrier** on call; names and numbers will be posted in the Show Office.

10. No refund of entry fees after the official entry closing date of the show unless a veterinarian or doctor's certificate is submitted by June 21, 2024. The administration fee will not be refunded for any reason.

11. **Memberships:** You must attach a copy of your current AEF membership card or your provincial organization (PSO) if you reside outside Alberta) to your show entry form. Entries are incomplete without these copies.

12. **Entry Number:** Every horse must wear its competition number for the duration of the show whenever it leaves the stall. Failure to do so will result in a warning for the first offense and possible elimination from competition for subsequent offenses.

13. **Scheduling** of classes will be dependent on entries received. Ride times will be emailed by June 18, 2024. Please ensure all documents are completed so that ride times can be scheduled accordingly.

14. Protests have to be made in writing within 48 hours of the competition and must be accompanied with \$50.00 Please refer to 2024 Wild Rose Competition Program Rule book.

15. Reading of Tests: Readers will not be provided.

17. All mounted riders are required to wear a secured ASTM/SEI approved safety helmet <u>AT</u> <u>ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS</u>, regardless of age. Noncompliance will result in elimination.
