

ADA Lifetime Achievement Award

(Official Launch of Program: November 1, 2020)

Purpose: to honour and recognize those individuals who have supported, promoted, and participated in the sport dressage in Alberta.

“Lifetime” implies a significant contribution to dressage in our province whether it be past and/or present.

Possible recipients may be nominated by area groups, individuals, or groups of individuals. Complete and submit the Application Form by the end of the calendar year with presentations being made the following year. Applications will be submitted to ADA Awards Committee via the ADA secretary for consideration and approval.

Awards will be presented annually at the Alberta Mane Event; if that event is not possible, then presentations will be made at the site of a significant gathering of dressage riders and supporters.

Nominees must have:

- Participated a minimum of 25 years in the Alberta dressage community
- Competed at the FEI test levels at sanctioned events

Other Criteria for consideration:

- Contributes to the education of riders and/or anyone interested in dressage. Examples suggested but not limited to Coaching/Teaching dressage lessons; running clinics with a dressage focus; other educational events
- Has been or is an active member of their local club or area group including volunteerism
- An ambassador for the sport of dressage
- Other significant contributions not detailed above

Nominees do not need to have fulfilled all of the above Criteria.
